1. Approval of February 8 minutes (approved KW, SD-A) and of March 22 agenda (approved KW, BM)

2. Principal Report (Paula McGuirk-Lemay)

- Many of our students will be observing Ramadan from March 23rd to April 20th. They will be fasting from sun up to sun down. To support them with this, we have set up a Junior and an Intermediate fasting room. We have also set up two prayer rooms for our students as they are required to pray five times throughout the day, one of which occurs during the school day.
- 2. Maker Space/Learning Commons Several staff members have agreed to join our committee. I have reached out to other schools regarding companies they have used and Brezach Education designed the space in many schools. I requested a consultation

to look at design possibilities. Estimated cost is between \$15 000 and \$20 000.

- A French teacher, Eric Duguay, has been hired to take over for Mr Prudhomme. He will begin Monday, March 27.
- Parent concerns over snow blocking sidewalks as well as several spaces in the daycare/kinder lot, making for congestion and dangerous walking. PM-L will speak with the area facilities supervisor for suggestions
- There is still a dance planned for April 28
- The spring concert start time is 6:30 (April 19)

7. Chair Report (Kate Woods)

- BM Movie night will be showing Strange World. Doors open at 6:00pm and the movie begins at 6:30pm. TC to set up the DVD player. Prices were decided at 25 cents for water and 75 cents for popcorn. BM will purchase two large bags of popcorn and three flats of water.
- LS Purdy's fundraiser was much smaller than the previous one with only 18 orders and \$288 raised (compared to \$950 on the previous round)
