- 1 pair of blunt scissors
- 2 large glue sticks

Grade 1 to Grade 3

- 12 pencils
- 2 erasers (preferably white)
- 1 package of crayons
- 1 package of coloured pencils
- 1 package of coloured markers
- 1 metric ruler
- 1 pair of blunt scissors
- 2 glue sticks

Grade 4 to Grade 8

- 12 pencils
- 2 erasers (preferably white)
- 1 metric ruler
- 1 pair of blunt scissors
- 2 glue sticks
- 3 ballpoint pens
- 1 package of coloured pencils
- 2 packages of 3-hole lined refill paper
- 6 duotangs
- 1 package of coloured markers
- 1 calculator
- 6 lined notebooks
- 1 geometry set
- 2 highlighters
- 3 binders
- binder dividers

*** Please label all items, including individual pencils, crayons, markers, and pencil crayons with your child's name or initials. It is also recommended that all students have a backpack, non-marking shoes suitable for outdoor physical education (no need for separate indoors and outdoors), and a lunch bag. Age and development level should be considered when selecting the size and type of these items. For example, students should have Velcro shoes until they are able to tie up laces quickly and independently. An extra change of clothes, socks, and/or outer wear may also be appropriate based on your child's needs and the weather. Please ask your child's teacher for input as needed.***
